Cast at 3g/m onto contoured 75–150 mm SikaRoof® Substrate bio-diverse UK. Seeds are best sown in late Autumn or early Spring, optimum seasons for sufficient warmth and moisture.

MAINTENANCE

Living roofs with good growing conditions will need annual maintenance for best results. This after-care will involve Spring weeding and Autumn strimming each year.
