PROJECT REQUIREMENT

As part of programme of improvements at Sextons Manor Community Primary School in Bury St Edmunds, the construction of a new extension, which would provide the school with two extra classrooms, had to be in keeping with the rest of the buildings on site.

The roof of the new class base extension required a waterproofing membrane that would match with the existing metal roofs. However, copper could not be used as there was a risk of theft.

The client also required a long-lasting, durable solution that could be installed quickly and efficiently, while being cost effective.

Sika Sarnafil membrane G410-15 EL in Patina Green, along with décor profiles, were specified for the roof of the new building, as the colour and look would emulate the existing copper roofs perfectly.

A flawless application of the membrane was achieved by award-winning roofing contractor, Gray & Jarrett Ltd. Elements of the roof were constructed on site, including the pitch and roof gully. The area where the new class base joined the existing one had to be adjusted to suit the detailing required, but thanks to the use of the Sarnametal this was not a problem.
