PROJECT REQUIREMENT

The Wentworth Mausoleum is part of an historic village estate and was erected by William Fourth Earl Fitzwilliam in 1784 in memory of his Uncle Charles, Second Marquess of Rockingham, who was buried in York Minster. It is the property of the Fitzwilliam Wentworth Amenity Trust and was recently restored so that it could be opened to the public.

The Mausoleum Lodge is an octagonal building and stands at the gateway to the grounds. At the rear of the lodge is a flat roof area that required a new waterproofing system.
