EVERBUILD® Boiled Linseed Oil is a traditional wood treatment used to restore the natural sheen in aged/tired wood. Quicker drying than raw linseed oil, this product may also be used with mastic sand to make a trowel grade pointing mastic.

USES

- Restores the natural sheen in tired/aged wood.
- Can be used to make a traditional pointing mastic.

Packaging	500ml plastic bottle
Shelf Life	24 months from date of manufacture.
Storage Conditions	Store in cool dry conditions away from direct sunlight between 5°C and 20°C. Store in original containers and out of reach of children. Dispose of product and packaging correctly.

- Suitable for internal or external use.
- Gives wood a natural finish.
- Works on most types of unpolished timbers.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT

Ensure surfaces are clean, sound, dry and free from polish or paint.

APPLICATION

Apply liberally with a cloth or brush until wood is saturated. Remove excess with a cloth after saturation.

CLEANING OF TOOLS

Clean brushes with Everbuild® white spirit.

LIMITATIONS

- Always replace cap after use.
- Use only as directed.
- Do not allow to enter watercourses.
- It is user's responsibility to determine suitability for use. If in doubt please contact Technical Services for advice.
