## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### APPLICATION

Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> SBV 08 is loose laid accordance with installation instructions: Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> PVC membranes. Adjoining sheets must overlap by ~150 mm. Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> SBV 08 needs to be secured with ballast (gravel, soil or plants) immediately after installation.

#### LIMITATIONS

Installation work must only be carried out by Sika<sup>®</sup> trained and contractors, experienced in this type of application.

- Do not use for permanent exposure to UV radiation.
- Do not use as a primary waterproofing membrane.
- Ensure Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> SBV 08 is prevented from direct contact with incompatible materials (refer to compatibility section).
- Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> SBV 08 must be installed by loose laying and without stretching or installing under tension
- The use of Sikaplan<sup>®</sup> SBV 08 is limited to geographical locations with average monthly minimum temperatures of - 50 °C. Permanent ambient temperature during use is limited to + 50°C.
- The use of some ancillary products such as adhesives, cleaners and solvents is limited to temperatures above + 5 °C. Observe temperature limitations in the appropriate Product Data Sheets.
- Special measures may be compulsory for installation below + 5°C ambient temperature due to safety requirements in accordance with national regulations.
