APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT

Ensure that timber to be treated is clean. Any paint or other surface coatings should be removed prior to application. Remove badly infected or structurally unsound timber and replace with sound timber prior to application.

APPLICATION

READ STATUTORY CONDITIONS RELATING TO USE PRIOR TO APPLICATION.

Shake well before use. Apply by brush, spray or dipping. Apply a minimum of two coats if brushing or spraying. The second coat should be applied after the first coat has soaked in but before it is dry.

Pay particular attention to thoroughly soaking the end grain. Where possible, dip or flood the end grains of the timber for maximum protection.

CLEANING OF TOOLS

Remove as much product as possible from brush or spray equipment and then clean with soapy water.
