### Sika Parex® Historic Mortar


A traditional hydrated lime, sand. GGBS mortar for brickwork or stonework. Can be injected into joints as narrow as 5mm and depending on the joint width, will penetrate to a depth in excess of 100 mm, allowing for the deepest of joints.

### Sika Parex® Historic KL Mortar

Designed for gun-injection, Parex® Historic Mortar KL is suitable for use with dense masonry and brick tiles, eg. Corium Brick Cladding System, is limited.

### Sika Parex® Standard Mortar

A brick pointing mortar that provides a clean, quick, lasting solution for pointing sound brickwork or masonry. Finished joints are highly where porosity is low and suction resistant to weather and freezethaw action.
