Installation work must only be carried out by Sika® trained and approved contractors, experienced in this type of application.

- The use of SikaRoof® Control Pipe Set PVC is limited to geographical locations with average monthly minimum temperatures of -50 °C. Permanent ambient temperature during use is limited to +50 °C.
- The use of some ancillary products such as adhesives, cleaners and solvents is limited to temperatures above +5 °C. Observe temperature limitations in the appropriate Product Data Sheets.
- Special measures may be compulsory for installation below +5 °C ambient temperature due to safety requirements in accordance with national regulations.

ECOLOGY, HEALTH AND SAFETY

Fresh air ventilation must be ensured, when working (welding) in closed rooms.

- Directly fasten the control pipe flange (using 4 fasteners) onto the vapour control layer / barrier to the substructure
- Continue with the for the project selected roof build-up
