## 2-Component, epoxy repair mortar

### Product Description

Sika® Repair EP is a thixotropic , 2-component repair mortar , based on a combination of epoxy resins with refined quartz fillers.

### Uses

A repair mortar for a variety of applications :

- Repair mortar for concrete, cement mortar and stone
- Filling holes and damaged corners, edges and joint sides in concrete
- Rigid interpretation of broad, non -moving joints
- Filling and sealing of cracks (no movement)
- Excellent for manufacturing skirting, coving or sanitary baseboards for floor / wall connections

<b>Application Details</b>	
<b>Substrate Quality</b>	The substrate must be sound and of sufficient compressive strength (minimum 25 N / mm <sup>2</sup> ), with a minimum bond strength of 1.5 N / mm <sup>2</sup> . The surface should be clean, dry and free of dirt, oil, grease and other impurities. Concrete must be at least 4 weeks old.
<b>Substrate Preparation / Priming</b>	Concrete, mortar, stone, bricks: The substrate must be sound , dry, clean and free from dirt, ice, standing water, grease , oils, old surface treatments or coatings and all loose or friable particles must be removed to an open textured and fine adhesive surface to obtain, free of laitance and curing compound etc.
<b>Application Conditions / Limitations</b>	
<b>Substrate Temperature</b>	+10°C min.; +30°C max.
<b>Ambient Temperature</b>	+10°C min.; +30°C max.
<b>Material Temperature</b>	+10°C min.; +30°C max.
<b>Dewpoint</b>	Beware of condensation! The ambient temperature during application must be at least 3 ° C higher than the dew point.
<b>Application Instructions</b>	
<b>Mixing Ratio</b>	Component A : Component B = 97,12 : 2,88 (by weight)
<b>Mixing</b>	Dosed sets: Mix parts A and B at least 3 minutes with a mixing paddle in a slow speed electric drill (max 400 rpm) until a smooth homogeneous material forms in a uniform grey colour. Only mix enough Sika® Repair EP that is workable within the processing time .

<b>Application Method / Tools</b>	<p>To the substrate surface, apply a bonding/priming layer of Sikafloor®-156, the fresh Sika Repair EP mortar should be applied to the still tacky primer .</p> <p>On ceilings, apply in successive layers of up to 10 mm.</p> <p>On vertical surfaces applied in layers up to 25 mm without formwork.</p> <p>Maximum horizontal layer thickness : 60mm.</p>														
<b>Cleaning of Tools</b>	<p>Clean all tools and application equipment with Sika Thinner C immediately after use. Hardened material can only be mechanically removed.</p>														
<b>Pot life at 20°C</b>	<p>Approx 90 minutes at +20°C.</p> <p>Pot life starts at the point the two components are mixed together. It will be shorter at higher temperatures and longer at low temperatures.</p>
